A Word About Enzyme Activity

Enzyme potency is best defined in terms of activity, not weight. Weight measurements can be misleading, as there is no direct relationship between weight and activity. For example, low potency enzymes may weigh as much as those with high potency, and fillers may add to the weight but not the effectiveness of an enzyme supplement. The national standard for measurement is Food Chemical Codex (FCC) Units. Simplicity's enzymes are made according to the FCC method and use the FCC measuring system to define enzyme potency.

Other Ingredients

Rice Bran, plant fiber.

Suggested Use

One capsule with water just before eating, or as needed. You may wish to adjust this amount based on your individual needs.

Storage

Keep in a cool, dry place.
